Norek Banners! Remember if you do not have a registered device and wish to display something at events paint up a Norek in your choice of colours and bring it along, proportions are up to you but too big can cause problems with the addition of wind, 60cm wide by 90cm deep seems to work. To display your banner you will need a 3m pole (25mm dowel works well) and a way to secure the banner to the pole, 8mm dowel cross bars are good and if you don't have the tools or just want advice come along to one of the Open House workshops and we can show you the finished product or help you make your own. There are enough Eric posts for everybody at the moment.
