


Also, I have some nifty fabric Noreks that need new backings, so perhaps we can hold another Banner Workshop to add to the event decorations.





Cost will be \$2.50 for members and \$7.50 for non-members (to cover event membership).



It is also my intention to run a Monthly combat archery training down at Wandu. It will be held on the 4th Sunday of the month starting in October (Due to other events it can't be started earlier) from 1pm to 4pm. A number of activities will be run including some of the following:

- 1 - combat archery
- 2 - Variations of the Agincourt run including allowing target archers to shoot while wearing helmets,
- 3 - Armouring work...
- 4 - Making combat blunts
- 5 - Helping people determine what they need to get or make.

These will not necessarily run at the same time but a selection will be done at each training day. The costs will be the standard charges Abertridwr levies for attendance. In addition, we will also be looking at where we can make savings either through targeted workshops to make gear, or by buying equipment in bulk.



Combat Archery Tourney

Greetings,

I will be running a combat archery tourney at the Wandu Community Centre which is on De Haer Rd, Wandu. It will be on the 21st August and start at 12pm.

Pricing will be \$5 per adult and teenage member, member children 12 and under are free. All non-members (adult, teenager, children) will need to pay \$5 extra for event membership.

Tournament Format:

The tournament will be between teams of two consisting of one target archer and one combat archer.

Each team will start with a point score of 100 points and will lose points depending on how the team goes. The team with the highest score at the end of the day will be the winners.

Round 1:

This will be an open field tourney for the combat archers where every archer is their enemy. Each combat archer will have three lives and when they lose a life 5 points will be deducted from their teams score. They will be given 3 ribbons each and to resurrect they will have to hand a ribbon to their target archery partner who will need to shoot up to three arrows at a time and score more than 5 points on a standard target set 20 yards away. If they fail they can recover their arrows and try again.

The round will end when one third of the combatants have lost all their lives.

Combat archers can make temporary alliances but remember if you step more than 5 metres from your alliance partner they can terminate the alliance by terminating you and vice versa.

If the target archer is less than 10 years old they will shoot from 10 yards.

Once the target archers have shot, their combat archery partners will take to the tourney field which will consist of two 2.5metre diameter circles set 8 metres apart. The archers will engage and whoever loses the bout will have 5 points deducted from their teams score. If a double kill occurs or the archers run out of arrows then both teams will lose 5 points.



Round 2:

This will be an Agincourt type run. All of the combat archers will have three lives and stand 40 metres away from the target archers. The target archers will use combat legal bows and blunts and stand behind a “castle wall” through which archery slits have been placed. The target archers will shoot at the combat archers until all the combat archers either reach the revetment set at 5 metres from the target archers or have been killed – NOTE: care will need to be taken that you don’t shoot their own combat archer.

As with the previous round 5 points will be deducted when a combat archer dies. The round will end when 3 runs have been made.


Round 3:

The final round will be a round robin. Target archers will have 3 arrows to shoot and the combat archers will have the number of arrows they use determined by the scores of their respective target archery partners.

To start each round the target archers from each pair of teams will shoot three arrows at a period target face where the outer white counts as 1, the green as 2 and the yellow as 3. Each archer will then total their scores and this will be the number of arrows their combat archery partner takes on the field with the minimum being 1 arrow (in case an archer misses the target altogether). The archer with the lowest score in each round will have 5 points deducted from their teams score.



Competitors are advised to wear comfortable garb suited to walking and shooting and also to bring plenty of spare arrows as you WILL break / lose a couple.








Dragon's Lair


