Western Raids - Dragon's Bay

We have a –

Breakfast team, lunch team, Silk Road coordinator, feast team, A+S person, and fighting (except war) coordinator all under control

Booking process for key equipment underway as we need to lock it in to ensure we can get what we need

Approval for fridge - \$396 plus credit card fees Delivered Friday morning, pick up Monday afternoon Approved by Magdalena; seconded by Sorcha Tables, marques etc - \$1840 (\$40 under budget!) Approved – Christopher, seconded by Sorcha

<u>Feasts</u> – seeking approval to allow cooks to start working towards feeding everyone for the weekend with an advance on funds. Funds will not be given out until May due to 30-day rule, but due to Galen and Magdalena both being away in April approval sought now for future funds to be given

Magdalena has reviewed budget and is happy with the use of funds. Cost breakdown of \$17 feast; \$12 silk road, \$5 breakfast per person – lunches done by college

Potential Royal event – budget may be exceeded per head based off previous quote but not by much

Preapproval of funds to be distributed within 30 days of event for 100 bookings, with approval for the rest to be done closer to event

Funds for breakfast, Silk Road and Feast

Approved – Sorcha, seconded by Malakai

<u>Marketplace</u> – If you want to sell things, talk to Loki who is running Silk Road Some people are looking to sell things for the entirety of the event, outside the designated Silk Roads event time, talk to Loki not Galen about this

<u>Tavern</u>? - Need to rebrand 'tavern events' due to negative connotations and potential for binge drinking and anti-social behaviour

Anti-social behaviour happened regardless last Raids, so not fair to blame tavern nights

Moving into a new 'branding' for the event, so although there were positive memories linked to tavern nights, we're moving away from it as people don't remember the good, and focus on the bad

<u>Food</u> - Please be more transparent with how food is to be paid for because no one knew what beads are for?

Beads didn't work

Slowed down food service due to haggling People lost beads due to not knowing importance Beads value?

Message Galen all question / comments / concerns Booking info will go out in next 24 hours, Magdalena to approve ASAP

General Business

Thank you from Crown Kitchen team and events team to Dragons Bay – lent platters, a list tree, a 3x6 pavilion and bollards last minute to Aneala (including Magdalena's last minute mercy dash down to the storeroom to unlock and help climb over things to get out!)

Crown sewing team made some green and white table clothes and banners, so the Canton had a presence at the event as did the College
